Highlights from the year

Fundraisers:

Toasting the Arts at Modales in May was successful! Fall Winemakers Charity Dinner hosted by Paul Hix and Michael Morey

Art Fair:

First year shuttle parking – a success! On Saturdays we had 435 rides, On Sunday we had 94 rides, For a total of 529 rides. Strong visitor numbers (tracked using cell phone data) 4,500 visitors, 2.5k more than last year.

Capitol Projects

January and February Bathroom Repairs

The bathrooms had suffered water damage in 2021 and 2022 due to roof leaks. The bricks within the wall had become completely damaged and needed to be replaced, and as well as the wood framing and drywall. Insulation was added, wainscoting was removed and walls were repainted. These updates were added to improvements made in 2021 which included new toilets and ventilation.

Remodel of the Pocket Gallery

The pocket gallery, which features seven exhibitions a year and is scheduled through 2027, received a full remodel in February and March of 2024. Pipes and outlets were removed to make a cleaner wall space, drywall was added for easier exhibition hanging as well as track lighting, the paneled season was replaced with drywall and the floor was flattened and had vinyl installed. This was thanks to a grant for \$19,600 from the Timken Foundation.

Upstairs repair plaster and replace lighting

Additional damage was caused to the walls and ceilings on the second floor of the building from roof leaks before and during roof replacement. While the City funded the repairs, we added 12k funding from the MACC and 10k funding to replace the lighting and paint the entire upstairs. Started in August 2024, finishing in September 2024.









Exhibitions

In our main gallery, the Center featured a total of 116 artists across four exhibitions.

- Experimentation, Exploration, and Exuberance: Give It a Try! juried by Alisa Clark with 43 artists
- Every Picture Tells a Story Member Exhibition featuring 37 artists
- Uncommon Folktales, a group exhibition of four artists
- Fantastical juried by Aubrey Jewel Rodgers featuring 32 artists

Pocket Gallery

 Featured eight exhibitions from September 2023 through August 2024, exhibiting fourteen artists

Student Exhibitions in March and April

 Exhibited work from South Haven, Bangor, Covert, and Bloomingdale Public Schools as well as St. Paul, St. Basil and the VBISD. We added more family programming and framed work for extended display at the South Haven Memorial Library.



Had a year of strong art sales all totaled and solid visitor-ship.

We expanded gallery hours to five days a week.

Expanded Children'sProgramming Highlights

- Started a year-round after-school program called Center Studio on Wednesdays for 8-12 year-olds, served 62 young artists served over 25 weeks.
- Five week adult and child open studio for 4-8 year-olds over the summer
- Skill based classes for teens including four week charcoal still life class with Kayla Ridley and four week water color class with Robin Reva
- Six weeks Friday summer classes lead by Romy Ransom and intern Keara Moore
